**SPECIAL** 

**REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must possess a minimum of three years general experience plus

three years specialized experience (in substantial investigative work, preferably criminal). Education substitution for some general experience may be available for education above the high school level in accredited institutions. The position requires travel for investigation, hearings and

training. Fluency in Spanish is beneficial.
